

Ophthalmology internship

The internship program is supposed to start September 1st, 2018 and offers an intensive clinical and surgical introduction into small animal ophthalmology. Under the guidance of an ECVO diplomate the intern is expected to assist in the daily ophthalmologic consultations, to take responsibility for in-house patients, assist in training of undergraduate students and general interns, and to help with ophthalmic emergencies. The aim is to prepare the candidate for an ophthalmology residency program.

Required requisites:

1. Licensure to practice as a veterinarian in Germany (DVM degree or equivalent).
2. Preferably one year general internship or two years postgraduate experience
3. A good command of German and English both orally and in writing (German: level B1 or higher).
